

CADA/CASL High School Summer Leadership Camp CODE OF CONDUCT & CAMP INFORMATION



CADA/CASL has put together an exciting and informative Summer Leadership Camp Program designed to improve your skills, provide hands on training, increase your awareness, and alert you to various responsibilities. To ensure that you will benefit the most from CADA/CASL Leadership Camp we have included some information on activities and items to bring to camp.

PROCEDURAL CHANGES

- *NEW THIS YEAR: Please carefully complete the student or adult <u>online</u> registration form. The link
 to the form was emailed to all registered advisors. If the advisor did not receive the email, please
 request a re-send by emailing <u>camp@cada1.org</u>. All students and advisors should complete this form
 by June 1.
- 2. *NEW THIS YEAR: All attendees should BRING TO CAMP, two (2) copies of the Medical Release & Policies Form, signed by parent/guardian. We will collect one copy at registration and the second copy will be folded and kept in the student's ID badge, in case of emergency. Please do not mail these forms. Bring them to registration on the first day of camp.
- 3. *NEW THIS YEAR: Each camper will be issued a UCSB dorm key and fob. CADA/CASL will NOT collect key deposits this year. However, schools may choose to collect a **key deposit** from students prior to camp. In the event of a lost key, CADA/CASL will bill the student's school for the replacement **cost of \$60**. At its discretion, the school may then charge the student's family for the cost.

TRANSPORTATION

- 4. Private cars driven by students will not be permitted. Students must ride to camp with their advisor, parents, or come by bus/train/plane. Students who bring cars will not be allowed to register, and will forfeit all camp fees.
- 5. Student delegations who are coming to camp by bus/train/plane must advise us on the advisor registration form. At UC Santa Barbara, shuttle service will be again provided through CADA Leadership camps, only on the first and last days of camp. Please book the train to and from the Goleta Station. We will NOT pick up from the Santa Barbara Station. This service is free this year, but you must reserve Shuttle spaces ahead of time.
- 6. If your travel plans change from what is listed on the registration form, please email updated information to camp@cada1.org. On the first day of camp, if you encounter any delays, please call Jeff Culver at 661-492-3202.
- 7. Specific directions to camp will be emailed to participants in the weeks prior to camp and will be available at cada1.org/leadershipcamps.

CONDUCT & BEHAVIOR

- 8. Students who use or possess drugs, liquor, tobacco in any form, or other items not usually allowed at schools will be sent home by common carrier at the parent's expense or detained until they can be picked up by a parent or school official, and will forfeit all camp fees. Please note that certain other rule infractions may justify these consequences.
- 9. All medications must be listed on the Medical Release and Policies Form and checked in at registration.
- 10. Name tags must be worn at all times, and you must have your name tag and key with you to eat in the dining hall.
- 11. Boys are not allowed in girls' dorm rooms and girls are not allowed in boys' dorm rooms. Please confine your visitations to the common areas.
- 12. Attendance is required at all sessions. Please be on time. If you are unable to attend a session because of illness, you must inform your advisor and the CADA Office staff.
- 13. Weather permitting, we will enjoy recreation time at the beach on day 3. While we are there students may enjoy the water up to their ankles, but are not permitted to go in the ocean any deeper.

CAMP PROGRAM NOTES

- 14. **Registration time is 11:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.** on the first day of camp. Please plan to arrive by 1:00 so that we will have adequate time to register you before the first session at 12:30 p.m.
- 15. The first **meal** at camp will be lunch on the first day of camp. There will be 3 meals served per day except for the last day, which will end with breakfast. A snack pack will be available upon departure at 11:15.
- 16. Structured camp activities will **end about 11:15 a.m.** on the last day followed by school planning time available until 12:15 p.m. Please schedule transportation to leave <u>after</u> 11:15 a.m. and allow as much time as possible to get you to the train, plane, or bus connection. That is usually a hectic time and the more time we have the better we can serve you.
- 17. Students may want to bring a little extra money to camp. **Snack items and CASL crewneck sweatshirts** (\$35) will be available at the camp store and the UCSB bookstore on campus will be open Monday-Friday during their summer hours.
- 18. School posters, banners, signs, and door decorations are fun! If you do happen to bring decorations please don't hang them outside the buildings. All material must be removed before check-out is complete. At UCSB decorations must be confined inside your sleeping room.
- 19. **Cell phones** are allowed at camp. Students will be able to access the **CADA/CASL Events mobile app** to plan their daily schedule (Camp Session will be available on the app near the end of June). We will also utilize Remind-type text messages and Push Notifications through the app throughout camp. Note: There is no wi-fi available for student use during the camp program.
- 20. Make sure you have an alarm to wake up on time!
- 21. **Dress** is school-casual for CADA/CASL Leadership Camps. <u>Please make sure your camp clothing is appropriate following your school's dress code</u>. It sometimes gets chilly in the evenings; a sweatshirt or light jacket is recommended.
