 - 2. SUMMER TRAINING Monday, August 6th, 2018 (12-2 pm)
 - 3. FRESHMEN SPIRIT PARTY Tuesday August 7th, 2018 **12-6pm** –**all coaches/advisors have agreed to this.**
 - 4. FRESHMAN HOMEROOM—each freshman homeroom has 3-4 SIBs assigned to it. You will be with your freshman homeroom at least one day per month and may be assigned to mentor students from that homeroom.
 - 5. MANDATORY MEETINGS—in the Harvard Room the FIRST THURSDAY of EVERY month.
 - 6. SCHOOLWIDE FOOD DRIVE—during school, likely November 2-9

 - 8. Volunteering Due to the community enhancement required with being a SIB, each member will be required to commit to 3 additional, approved activities throughout the year. Two unexcused absences from an event, responsibility, or monthly meeting will result in *dismissal* from SIBS. Work, homework, and other extracurricular commitments **DO NOT count as excused absences**.
