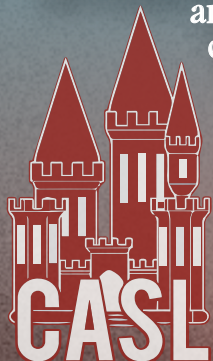

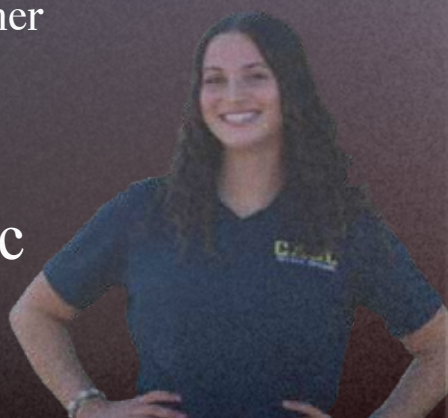
# LETTER FROM THE PRESIDENT

## NICKI JOINER

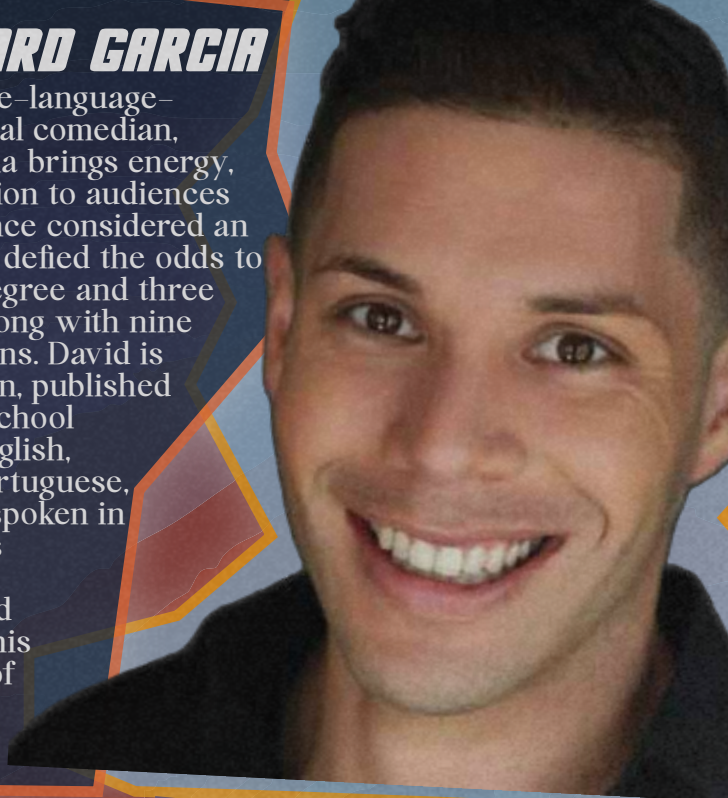

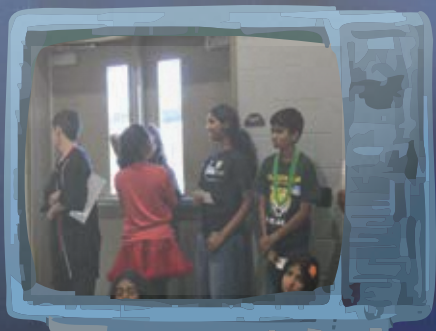
