## LDD GENERAL FAQ

Q: We are curious about the curriculum. Is it different every year?

A: Yes, we have a detailed agenda with well-paced curriculum, which will be provided to all advisors the day of your event. We write new curriculum every summer with a specialized focus for the year (for example, last year was cultural competencies). The new curriculum begins with the first LDD of the school year (typically late August).

Q: I've heard this is an active training. What should my students wear?

A: Please dress comfortably! The activities we'll be engaging in are high-energy and require a bit of moving around. The best thing your students can do to prepare is get rest and be ready as it is a long day in which they need to be "all in" for the whole day! Also, make sure the facilitators arrive on time (7:30) as training needs every minute. The other skills they will need throughout the day I am sure they have been learning in leadership class all along (respect, communication, initiative, flexibility, empathy) and will get a chance to really put them into practice.

Q: We have a few students with dietary needs. Do you have options for students with special dietary restrictions?

A: All students will be provided with a cold cut Subway sandwich (turkey-based), chips, rice krispie treat, and water. Please inform us of any special needs one week prior to the LDD. There are vegetarian and gluten free options available by request only. Vegetarian tickets will be provided for the advisor that morning.

Q: What do the delegates need to bring?

A: Bring a positive spirit & willingness to learn! All materials plus a snack, sub sandwich lunch and the training are provided.

Q: I've heard a lot about what my students will be doing. What is the teacher's role during the day?

A: Feel free to observe, take notes, and prepare to debrief with your students afterwards. An agenda will be provided for you to reflect and debrief with your students about the lessons gained from the curriculum.

Q: Should I send payment in early? When is the last day to register/send payment?

A: Registration is limited to the first 300 applicants, and payment is due one week prior to the LDD date.

Q: Is there a special schedule for the day for the Host Site?

A: The schedule for the day is as follows:

7:00am- LDD Coach arrives

7:30am- LDD Coach trains facilitators

9:00am- Delegates arrive promptly for training

12:00pm- Lunch

1:30pm- End of training
