

MHS Leadership Book

Leadership offers many essential lessons that you will take with you beyond the walls of MHS. In order to reflect upon the many lessons that you will become skilled at, you will be required to produce a Leadership Book. You can be as creative as you want, but it must contain the following items in the listed order. This book will be part of your grade each quarter. In this book, each quarter will be a separate 'chapter.' I will not go back and re-grade each quarter. This will end up being a complete book, but will be done in quarter increments.

Quarter 1 Pages due Monday, September 19 (the day before midterms start)

Page 1 Title Page
Must include your "theme title" for your book, your full name, and the school year (2016- 2017). The back of this page will be blank.

Page 3 New Page- This is your butterfly page. You can draw a butterfly on the page if you want, but there are going to be two additional goals that must be included.
Please put the 4 goals that you put on your butterfly:

1. What will you do to affect one life this year?
2. What will you do to affect Leadership this year?
3. What will you do to affect your life this year?
4. What is one word that describes you and how you will accomplish the first three questions?
5. What do you want to learn in leadership this year?
6. What do you want to accomplish outside of leadership this year?

Page 4 This is the back of your butterfly page. Here you will find quotes from famous people that mean something to you. You must have at least 5 quotes on this page. Do some research and find some quotes that are meaningful. Please keep in mind the following limitations:

- You can only have one anonymous quote.
- You can only have one quote from a sports person OR one from a pop star.

Your quotes should be from people that have changed the world or done something good in the world.

- You must use a variety of individuals for your quotes.
- You cannot have 2 quotes from the same individual.
- You may not use any family members.

You must write after each quote what they quote means to you.

Page 5 New Page- Cut out an article from a magazine or newspaper. The article must be about someone that has made a difference in someone else's life. You must include the full article, not just a few lines. The article must be about someone that did something to help someone else in a positive way.

Page 6 This is the back of Page 5. What do you think about this article? How do you feel about it? Write a page about this article and how it affected you.

Page 7 "Meet Someone New" Page- You must have at least 2 pictures. Write an article about someone new- interview them! This person cannot be in any of your classes. You must go out and talk to them- talk to them about activities, what they like about school, what are they interested- clubs, sports, etc.

Quarter 2

Pages due December 12

- Page 1 'Caught in the Moment' page. Caught in the Moment page is you working on committees, doing a lunch Nest Competition, working a sporting event, working on stuff in leadership class. It is NOT a spirit day, rally, float building, or dress up pictures. Describe the pictures. What was the committee assignment? Why was your job important? This page must have 4 pictures.
- Page 2 This is the back of your Caught in the Moment page, where you will include 4 more pictures. Include the same information as page 1.
- Page 3 New Page- "Spirit Days/ Rally Days" This page includes pictures of you dressed up in rally clothes, at the rally, dressed up for Spirit Days. Make sure you take pictures of you doing things during Falcon Flight School, Week of Welcome, Club Rush, Homecoming, etc. (4 pictures)
- Page 4 This is the back of your Spirit Days/ Rally Days page. This page needs to include 4 more pictures in the same format.
- Page 5 New Page- This is the 'Best Things About Me' page. No friends on this page, this page is all about you and your family. Please explain who is in each of the 4 pictures.
- Page 6 This is the back of your 'Best Things about Me' page. You must write your personal story. What are your best qualities and why do you think these are your best? I don't want to hear about you being a good student, I want to hear about you being a good person!
- Page 7 New Page- 'Meet Someone New'- Follow the same guidelines as in quarter 1. Write an article, take pictures, get valuable information and talk with them about MHS.

- Quarter 3 Pages due by February 21
- Page 1 New Page- This page is your 'School/ Community Improvement Project' page. This page is dedicated to the project that you have contributed to that has led to the betterment of the school or the community. This page is pictures (4) of how you contributed to the event.
- Page 2 On the back of page 1- This page is a written explanation of the project that you contributed to. Your contribution should have left a noticeable difference in how this projects was run, completed, etc. This is a one page summary of what you did, why you did it, who benefited from it, who participated in it, how it made you feel during the project, etc. No Pictures are needed on this page.
- Page 3 New Page- This is the 'MHS Pride' page. Do not use any of the same pictures that have already been used. This can be Homecoming, Winter Formal, Nest meetings, Week of Welcome, band, drama, sports, clubs, etc. It is all about 'MHS Pride!' You can have one picture of sports, one of float building, one of clubs, etc. You must have 4 pictures and write about each picture. You cannot have more than one picture from each event.
- Page 4 Back of Page 3- Continuation of 'MHS Pride' page. Be sure to write about each of your pictures so people know what you are doing. 4 pictures for this page.
- Page 5 New Page- This page is called 'A Reflection of Me.' This page is all about Random Acts of Kindness. This has to be about you doing something nice for someone. Write the story- 1 page
- Page 6 Back of Page 5- This page is called 'I Admire.' You need one person that you admire. It cannot be a relative or a friend because it is assumed that they all know that you admire them. This goes along with your 'A Reflection of Me' page- this is someone that has done good deeds in their life, been honored for their contributions, participated in doing something for cancer, children, helping someone or a cause for something, etc. Someone that you greatly admire and want to model some of your behavior after them in the future (or now). You must have a picture of the person, their name, and written information about what they did that you admire and why.
- Page 7 New Page- You have met two new people so far this year... now go find a third! You must put their name, grade, and something about what they do or who they are. Interview them, write it up. Take pictures and put them on this page.

Quarter 4 Pages due by May 15

Page 1 New Page- Nest Activities- 4 pictures of you participating in at least 2 different nest activities throughout the year. Be in the pictures and explain what is happening in the pictures.

Page 2 Back of Page 1- Electronic Unity- Print out 4 screen shots of you in Electronic unity. You could be hosting, participating in a segment, making a club announcement, etc. With each picture, include the date that you appeared in Unity.

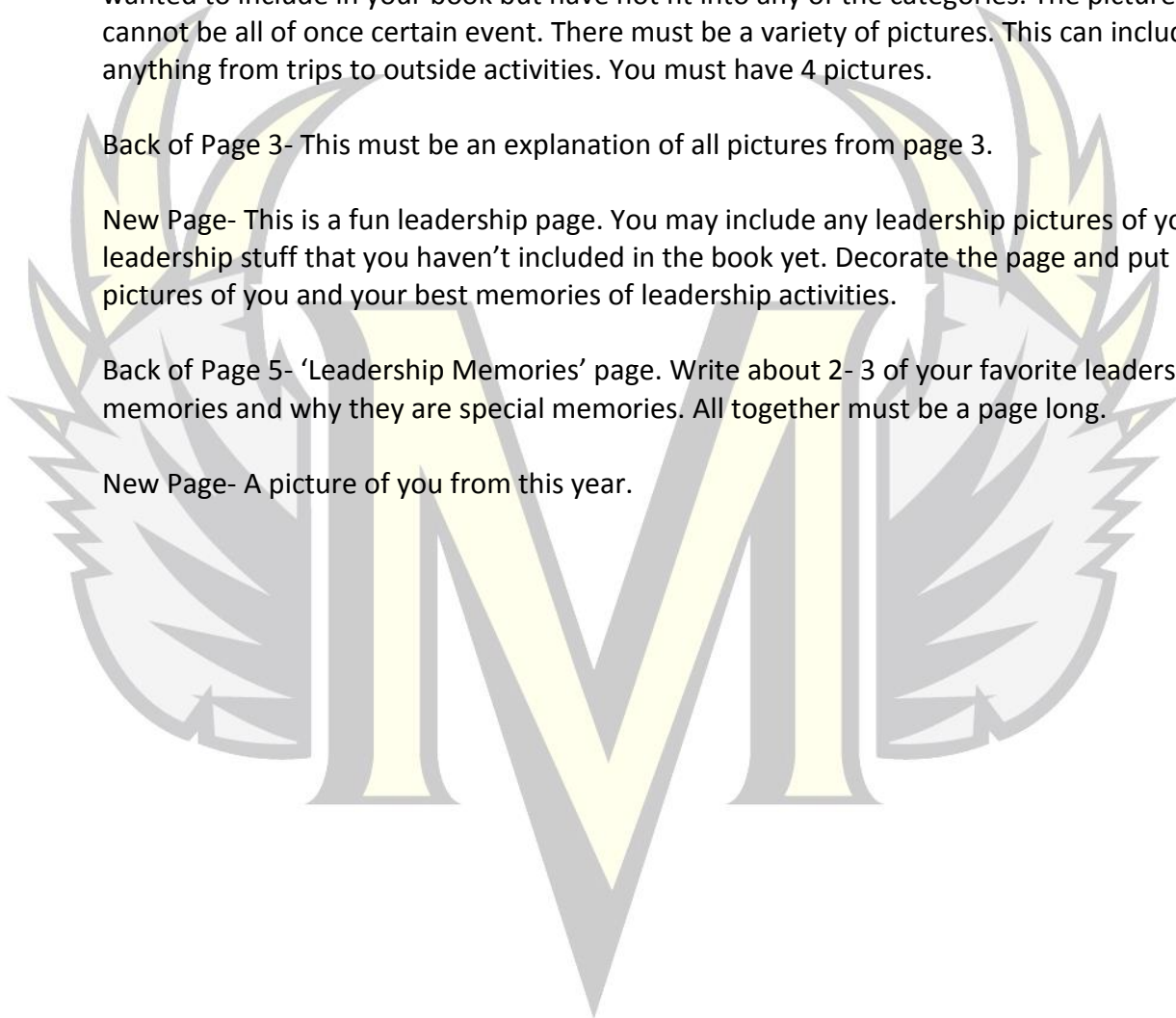
Page 3 New Page- 'My Memories' This page can have any pictures from the year that you have wanted to include in your book but have not fit into any of the categories. The pictures cannot be all of one certain event. There must be a variety of pictures. This can include anything from trips to outside activities. You must have 4 pictures.

Page 4 Back of Page 3- This must be an explanation of all pictures from page 3.

Page 5 New Page- This is a fun leadership page. You may include any leadership pictures of you doing leadership stuff that you haven't included in the book yet. Decorate the page and put in pictures of you and your best memories of leadership activities.

Page 6 Back of Page 5- 'Leadership Memories' page. Write about 2- 3 of your favorite leadership memories and why they are special memories. All together must be a page long.

Page 7 New Page- A picture of you from this year.
