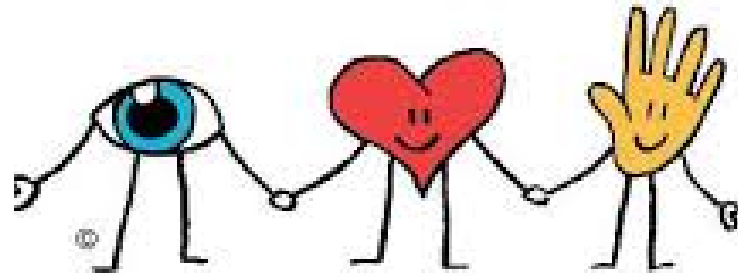
It is a simple principle we should all live by:
