









Suggestions/Examples

- Weekly meetings We meet weekly to go over all three entities
- Weekly facilities meeting to go over who is where and when
- Athletic Director sends out games of the week schedule
- Administration rotates and attends all home contests
- Activities Director attends Home games to operate gate/concessions. Athletic Director attends all home games for game management.
- Athletic Director is the adviser of the Club
- Activities Director assigns all adjunct duty for teachers (and is part of their evaluation) and schedules security as needed for athletics.
- Administration approves all fundraising and events on campus through the Activities Director
- All 3 entities meet to debrief events.


 EAP-emergency action plan, must be signed off by principal

- Activities Director deals with tickets, security and concessions
- Administration deals with security, fans and help either AD with any issues

- The more you meet, the more bonded you will become!


