COVID Vaccines for kids

At this point, it appears **unlikely** that **younger** school students will be able to receive a COVID-19 vaccine **before the start of the 2021** academic year. So they'll depend on widespread adult vaccination to keep them safe and healthy.

The Pfizer and Moderna vaccines have not been approved for use in children, though kids are now being included in trials.

What students and staff are facing

- Changes in daily routines
- Lack of predictability
- Increased fears about their safety and the safety of loved ones
- Extended periods of isolation

And, in some cases:

- Loss of a loved ones
- Limited access to food and safe shelter
- Abuse, neglect, exposure to violence



It's not going to be an easy road

The shutdown has caused new **conflicts** among and between **parents, teachers, employers**, and district leaders, as all negotiate the details of remote learning and whether schools should begin to offer inperson instruction.

Lack of **trust** among parents about **vaccinations** and health practices, and worries about especially **vulnerable children and teachers**, will persist beyond this school year.

Coronavirus-based disruptions to schools **could continue until at least 2024**, and worries about contagion will not go away.

Teachers' unions have been **strong opponents** of a quick return to in-person schooling, but they also have a strong stake in continuing arrangements that leave negotiations over schooling behind closed doors and protect traditional uses of funds and teachers



Money to support education

School leaders can leverage funds allocated in the 20-21 state budget, which included **\$5.3 billion** that schools can use to **support programs for social and emotional learning**



There will be more money coming

"The United States is committed to ensuring that students and educators are able to resume safe, in-person learning as quickly as possible, with the goal of getting a majority of K-8 schools safely open in 100 days,"



Biden has called on Congress to provide at least **\$130 billion** in dedicated funding to K-12 schools, as well as **\$350 billion** in flexible state and local aid that would help districts avoid layoffs and close budget gaps.

Social Emotional Learning for <u>ALL</u> students

Social and emotional learning, as a practice, is a set of strategies to help students develop the emotional skills that are vital for **success in school and life** — like developing **self-awareness**, navigating **healthy relationships**, and building **resilience**. Research shows that social and emotional learning gives students a greater **sense of trust and belonging**, makes schools **safer**, and significantly **increases academic achievement**.

Building and Sustaining Relationships

- Sense of Community: Create a school and classroom community no matter where instruction is taking place. Maintain connections virtually and based on social distancing guidelines with students, families and community partners.
- **Positivity:** Prioritize uplifting staff and students by sharing positive actions and behaviors through announcements, social media posts, newsletters and/or bulletin boards.
- Summer Contact: Offer virtual connection opportunities during the summer months so students can connect with peers and staff.
- **Build Familiarity:** Help new students get familiar with their new environment with pictures, social stories, videos of the building, or meet and greets with teachers.






