The student, Cameron, proceeded to share the story of his own academic struggles with my son. All the while, my son sat quietly and listened intently. When Cameron was finished talking, my son wiped away his tears, stood up, and stated that he was going to get back to work. My son later told me that it was really helpful to hear encouragement from someone other than his mother and father. He added that it was really nice to talk to someone whose story was so similar to his own. I am so grateful to Cameron and ALL of our students who have chosen to #GOKIND this year.






Awareness Campaigns


Humans of Great Oak
