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What is a Reward Zone?

- Acknowledgement program to reward students for positive:
 - Grades
 - Attendance
 - Behaviors
 - Test scores
- A time slot of varying activities
 - Movies
 - Fun assemblies/guest speakers
 - Video games, board games, sports
 - Field Trips
- Planned, organized, and ran by the HS Student Council members
 - Place them on teams; each team comes up with their group's activity
 - Students have to be active and involved with the event, building relationships with the younger students
 - As the advisor, I give the final ok for their activity
- Can happen monthly or quarterly

Who gets to attend?

- List is generated first based off grades
 - GPA for that period
 - No Ds or Fs
- Then it goes to the attendance clerk**
 - Less than 3 unexcused absences
- Next it goes to the strategist
 - Must have met or exceeded MAPS testing growth goal
- Finally, it goes to admin
 - No behavior referrals
